
### **Parking**

Both ON and OFF-STREET parking is available within Tralee town centre.

All zones are 'pay parking' with a low tariff and card & cash payment facilities.

Bands are advised to use the off- street option for parking with a preference for the Brandon and the Parklands car park facilities. (shown on the map below)

Tralee Municipal District, Kerry County Council will provide a number of 'parking passes' to bands for the occasion.



The concept of Pipe Fest is to get bands, pipers and drummers, together in a non-competitive environment and deliver a performance. This may be undertaken in any formation, with combinations of solo, group, whole band elements, alternative instruments are also welcome, anything goes, entertain and enjoy. ### **Massed Band**


All the bands who have taken part in Pipe Fest form up as a 'massed-band' and parade from the Ashe Memorial Hall, Denny Street to the Mall for the Finalé.

With the complete 'massed-band' in the Mall, the band will stop, cease playing and all members turn to the right.

A rolling parade will take place at 4.30 pm, North from the Ashe Memorial Hall to the Mall. The parade route length is 250m.

Tunes for the massed band will be Let Erin Remember, the Minstrel Boy & Mo Ghiolla Mear, all played individually, each tune played twice through before stopping.

The Mall will serve as the location for the Finalé. As the street will be closed to vehicular traffic at the time no special considerations are required.
