



Music of Historical Significance

Arena 1 15.30

70's Tribute Pipe Band

Secretary Kenneth Stewart, Pipe Major David Caldwell & Lead Drummer John Scullion recreate for us the historically significant first forays in pipe band Medley Selections of the 1970s.

Background

In the years before 1970 all Pipe Band Competition was based on the standard MSR format.

Then, in 1970, the Scottish Pipe Band Association took the decision to introduce Medley competition. Pipe Majors and Lead Drummers were now presented with the opportunity of creating performances, which would reflect their particular musical tastes.

Shotts and Dykehead Cal. opened their performances with marches composed by Tom Muirhead, an accordion player.

Edinburgh City Police Pipe Band concentrated on dance strathspeys, reels and jigs.

Glasgow Police Pipe Band won their first World Champion title in 1976.

Dysart and Dundonald Pipe Band introduced a new dynamic to the Medley performance in 1977.

The new medley performance also enabled the use of musical harmony and a new judging category of Ensemble was introduced.

Pipe Major David Caldwell and Lead Drummer John Scullion have formed the 70s Tribute Band with the aim to recreate some of the winning medley performances of that era.

Today they will perform the Shotts and Dykehead Caledonia Medley, which won the World Championship title in 1973.


