Step by Step Guide to Individual Garda Vetting

- 1. Download the IPBA Garda Vetting Application Form.
- 2. Complete the form and send it to Brian MacMahon, 39 Pondfields, New Ross, County Wexford. Y34 A326
- 3. <u>Enclose copies of TWO forms of ID</u> one of which should be a <u>Photo ID</u> and the other a <u>Proof of Current Address</u>. See below for further information.
- 4. All submissions for Vetting to the IPBA Vetting Officer must be submitted by a band's Designated Liaison Person (Child Protection Officer) rather than by the individual applying to be vetted.
- 5. The band's Designated Liaison Person must write the relevant day's date on each item. He/she must print his/her name on each of the items being submitted for identity purposes. The DLP must also initial or sign the documents.
- 6. The names, addresses and DOBs on the documents must be the same as on the Application Form (form NVB1).
- 7. Enclose a cheque for €10 payable to IPBA. (Please note that the €10 fee covers Carlow Volunteer Centre expenses and the Garda Vetting charge. The IPBA lodges the cheque and pays Carlow Volunteer Centre by quarterly invoice).
- 8. Carlow Volunteer Centre will create an e-vetting invitation using the data from this form and issue an invitation to you via an email link.
- 9. An electronic invitation via a secure email link will be issued to you and you can track your own application.
- 10. <u>The Link issued to you will remain active for 30 days only</u>. If you don't complete your online application in that time, you will need to start over again and go back to step 1. You will also be charged a second time.
- 11. On completion of your Garda Vetting, which should be within two weeks of receipt of your electronic application, The IPBA will receive your Garda Vetting. A copy of the Vetting Certificate will be e-mailed to you.

Please note the following:

THE NATIONAL VETTING BUREAU HAS ADVISED THAT ANY NORTHERN IRELAND ADDRESSES MUST HAVE THE 7 DIGIT POSTCODE OR THE APPLICATION WILL BE RETURNED TO BE COMPLETED AGAIN.

Forms of ID acceptable:

- 1. Photo ID: Passport, ID card with photo; Driver's Licence, etc.
- <u>Verification of Current Address</u>: Identification should be produced for the purpose of the verification of current address and may include recent utility bill (gas, telephone and electricity), Bank / Building Society / Credit Union statement heading and birth certificate. <u>All that is required is the Heading Part of your utility bill or statement i.e.</u> the part that shows your address and name.

<u>In the absence of this documentation</u>, an applicant has the option of swearing an Affidavit / Affirmation before a Commissioner of Oaths to verify their identity. Please note there may be separate requirements by a Commissioner of Oaths in this regard.
