



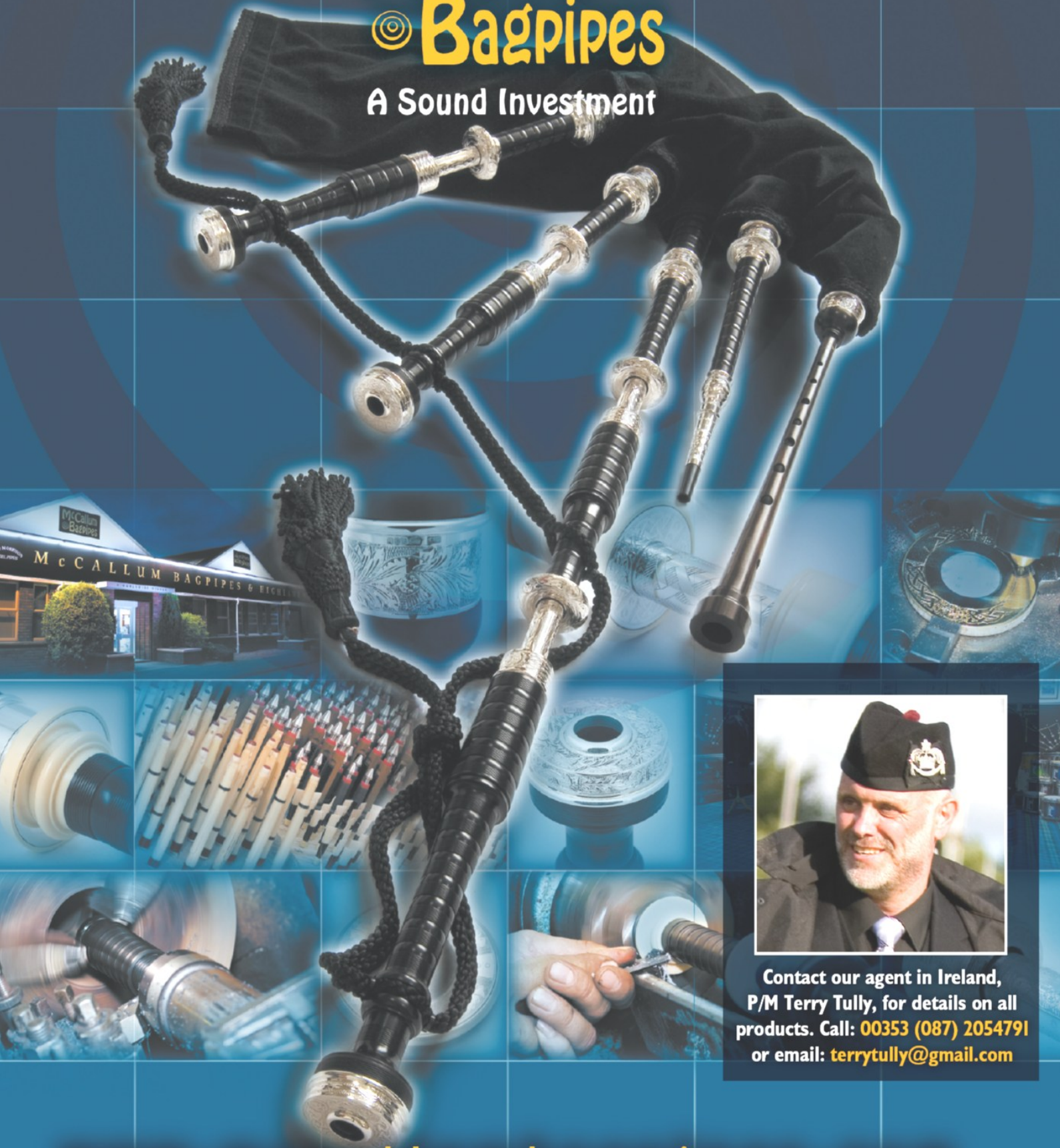

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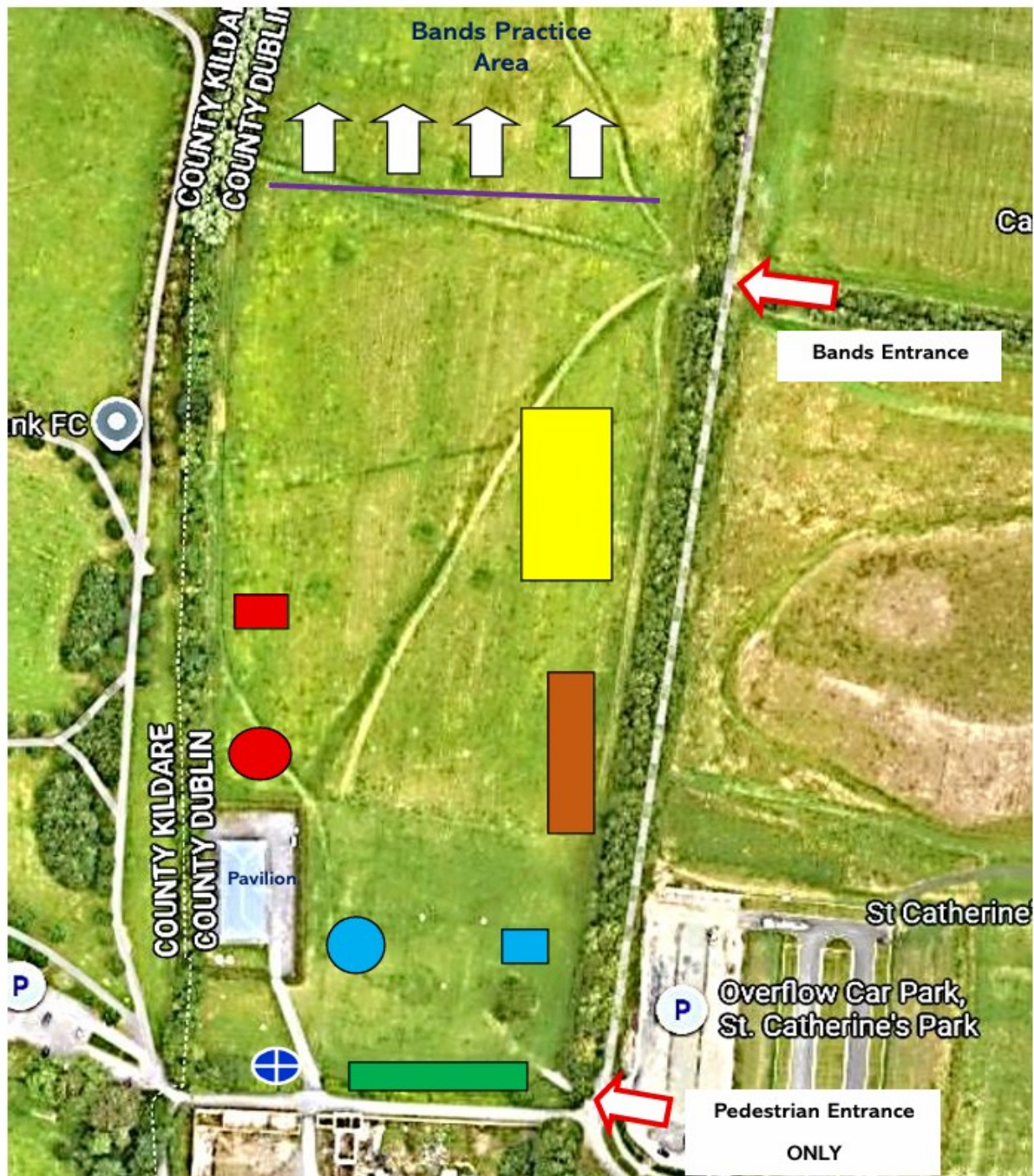

Connecting with History

In the years before 1970 all Pipe Band Competition was based on the standard MSR format.

Then, in 1970, the Scottish Pipe Band Association took the decision to introduce Medley competition. Pipe Majors and Lead Drummers were now presented with the opportunity of creating performances, which would reflect their particular musical tastes.

The 70s Tribute Band was formed with the aim of recreating some of the winning medley performances of that era.

Pipe Major David Caldwell and Lead Drummer John Scullion have reproduced the 1970 winning medley at the 2022 World Pipe Band Championships and, in 2024, the 1973 Shotts and Dykehead Cal. winning medley was displayed at the All Ireland Pipe Band Championships in Newbridge Demesne, Co. Dublin.

This year the 70s Tribute Band will display the **1980 Shotts & Dykehead Caledonia** winning medley.

During the 70s the format of the medley remained virtually unchanged and this performance is one of the last of that era.

Then, at the beginning of the 1980s the musical influence of Canadian Pipe Bands, such as the 78th Fraser Highlanders and the Simon Fraser University, and Irish Bands – St. Laurence O'Toole, began to force a change in the musical content of performances.
